\*\*NOTE: Completion of the Major Change Application Workshop is required the quarter in which <u>ALL</u> the above requirements are satisfied to apply to the School of Business. Students <u>must</u> apply to the School of Business when completed units are between 90-110. A cumulative GPA of 2.7 is required with a minimum above 2.5 GPA in the General Business Prerequisite area. Students should not enroll in upper division Business Admin. requirements until <u>ALL</u> the College breadth <u>AND</u> lower division Business prerequisites are completed. <u>Students must meet GPA requirements by the end of their freshman year or risk being discontinued from program.</u>
