Students must apply to the School of Business when completed units are between 90-110. A cumulative GPA of 2.7 is required with a minimum above 2.5 GPA in the General Business Prerequisite area. Students should not enroll in upper division Business Admin. requirements until ALL the College breadth AND lower division Business prerequisites are completed. Students must meet GPA requirements by the end of their freshman year or risk being discontinued from program.**
